

ARLEMONT LE HAUT



IGP COTEAUX D'ENSÉRUNE / CHÂTEAU RÉGISMONT

In the 17th century, the estate belonged to the Comte de Rougement, who named it “Régis Mont,” meaning the King’s Mountain. The Domaine de Régismont is located between Poilhes and Nissan-Lez-Ensérune. It borders numerous ruins that demonstrate a Roman presence on this land. Passionate winemakers for four generations from father to son, the Paillet family aims to constantly develop the vineyard, in order to provide ever more generous wines.

The Arlemont le Haut Collection has an inimitable identity. This trio of organically-farmed wines showcases family know-how that has been passed down from generation to generation. Carefully cultivated, the vines thrive and offer the best of their terroir. Each bottle is a harmonious blend of respect for nature, tradition and modernity.

Located between the villages of Poilhes and Nissan-lez-Ensérune.

CLIMATE

Mediterranean.

SOIL

Calcareous-clay and silicate-clay, with a few plots below the Oppidum d'Ensérune.

MERLOT RED

TASTING NOTES

Beautiful intense red colour. The nose offers sustained notes of ripe red and black fruit. The second nose reveals lovely spicy aromas.

Juicy on the palate, with supple, full-bodied tannins that develop with finesse and charm.

FOOD/WINE PAIRING

Goat's cheese, steak with pepper sauce, spicy food..

TEMPERATURE

16°C.

GRENACHE ROSE

TASTING NOTES

A superb, brilliant pale grey colour. The nose offers an avalanche of fruity aromas (cranberry, bilberry). The palate is lively and well-balanced, with a lovely freshness and subtle floral aromas.

FOOD/WINE PAIRING

Aperitif, tuna tart, world cuisine.

TEMPERATURE

8-10°C.

CHARDONNAY WHITE

TASTING NOTES

Attractive yellow colour with green highlights. The intense, complex nose reveals notes of yellow-fleshed fruit and white flowers. Fresh and round on the palate, with subtle buttery notes.

FOOD/WINE PAIRING

Chicken croquettes, rabbit with carrots, white pudding with port.

TEMPERATURE

10-12°C.
