Surface: 12hectares

50% CabernetFranc



Vinification

The respect of traditional rules to run the vineyard and the use of natural fertilizer restrict yield to 60 HI/ha.

The alternating grassy and ploughed rows lead to an ideal hydric balance.

Cabernet varieties especially communicate characteristic structure and fruitiness.

CHATEAU LAMOTHE BELAIR ROSE is seductive with its nose of banana, white peach, English sweets and blackcurrant.

A pale and modern colour. Floral and fresh notes.
